- 5. Restored Three Wheeler
- 6. Restored Step-thru Cushman and Allstate
- 7. Custom Class Cushman Powered, voted on by members
- 8. Modified Class Non Cushman Powered, voted on by members

Any scooter entered in the *Custom* or *Modified Class* must have a Cushman manufactured frame and at least three of the following from the Cushman Parts List.

Cushman Parts List

- 1. Rear fender or cover
- 2. Front fender or cover
- 3. Gas tank
- 4. Wheels or Hub
- 5. Handlebars or steering wheel
- 5. Front fork
- **9. Senior Class** Cushman prior first place scooter.
